We were invited by Burgess Hill Town Council to participate in 'What's in a Name' competition to name the new performance and community centre being built in Burgess Hill.

Our Year 10 students put forward a number of proposals and one of the names has been shortlisted.

BEEHIVE (The Beehive Centre) - We chose this because it is historically the name given to the tall conical shaped kilns which were on all of Burgess Hill's brick-making sites.
