What is the SIMS Student App?

The SIMS Online student app is a convenient new way to access your homework and find out what's going on at Downlands.

You can access the system easily from a smartphone, tablet or PC – anytime, anywhere.

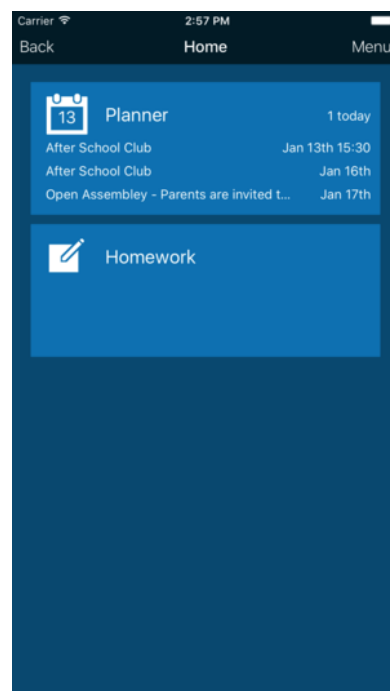
What will you find in the SIMS Student App:

- Important information such as your homework & timetable .
- School calendar, INSET dates and contact details available at the click of a button.

We will send you an activation email from noreply@sims.co.uk.

Please check your spam/junk mailbox if the email does not appear in your inbox.

Simply click on the link from your tablet, PC or smartphone and follow the activation process to create your account. You can login using your username & password for your normal school email account.





SIMS Student App – Register

Register - Step One

Login to your school email account. E.g 17astud@downlands.org.



There is a link on the school website.

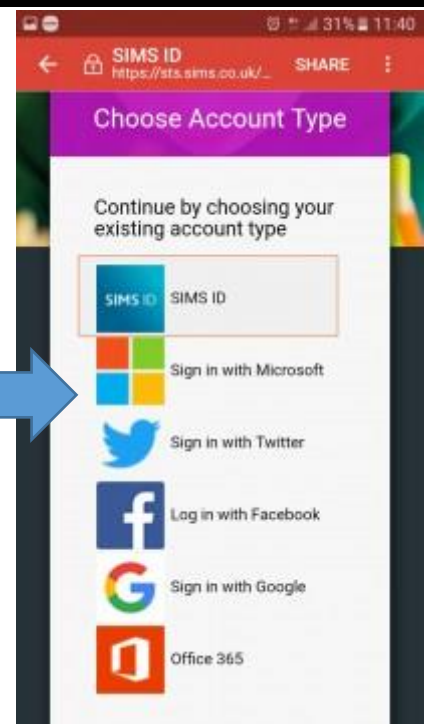
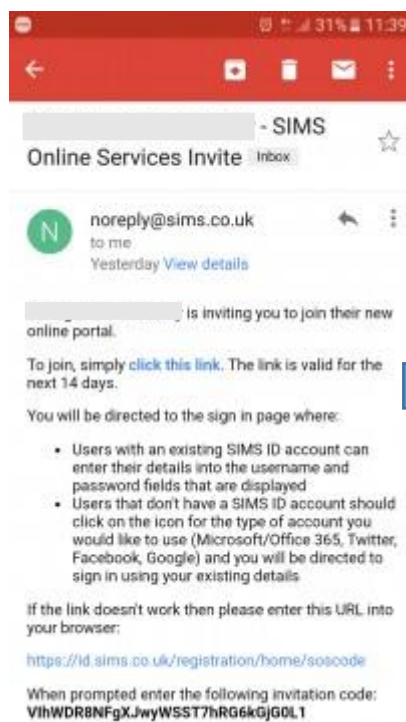
Open your invitation email that was sent to your school email address it will be from noreply@sims.co.uk.

The email may be in a folder called 'Following'.

Register - Step Two

Click on the link in the email.


Sign in using the Microsoft Account. (this is your school email again).





Register - Step Three

Check your name and click on the 'Register' button.

Type in your date of birth following the format of dd/mm/yyyy.

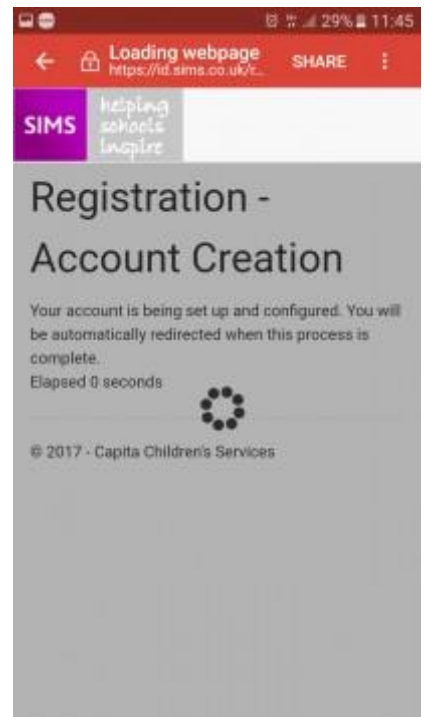
For example 26/02/2005

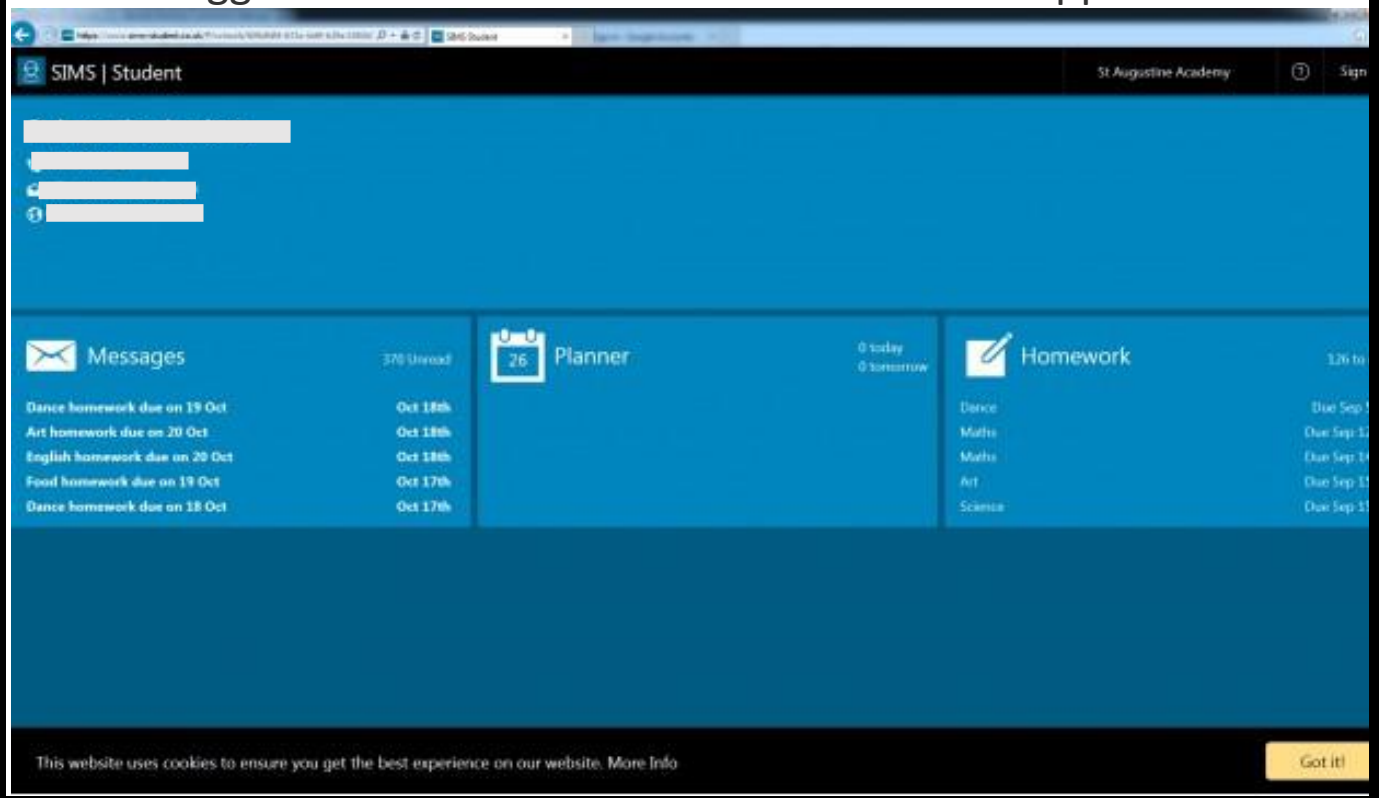
Register - Step Five

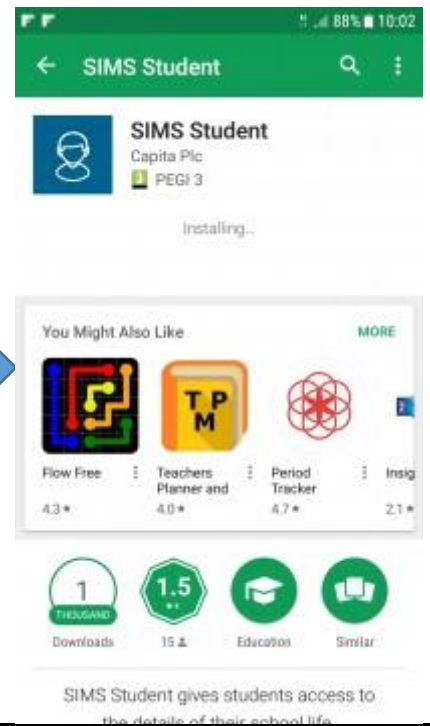
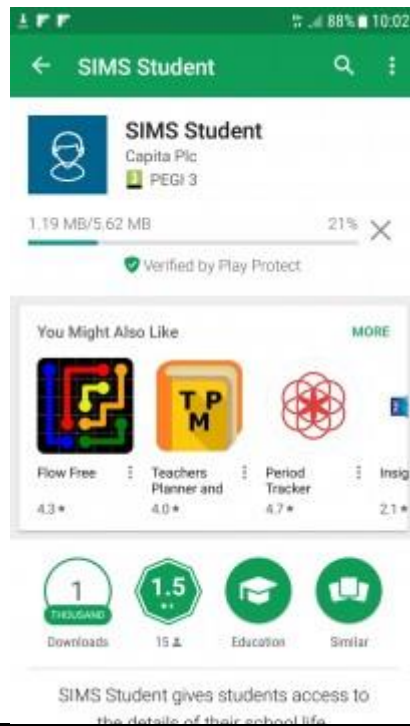
Go to the Google Play store or the Apple store and search for SIMS Student

Installing Student App – Step Three

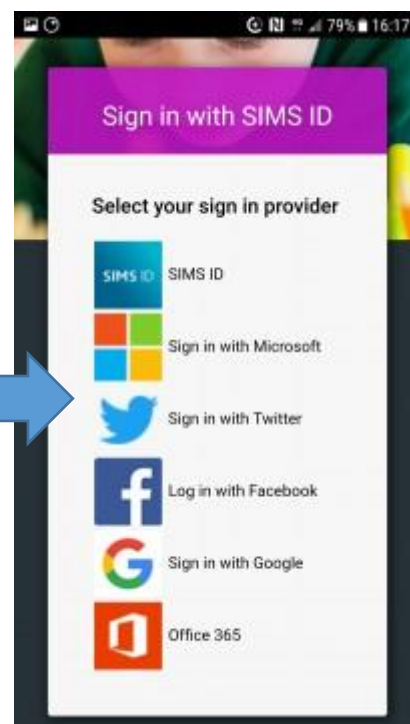
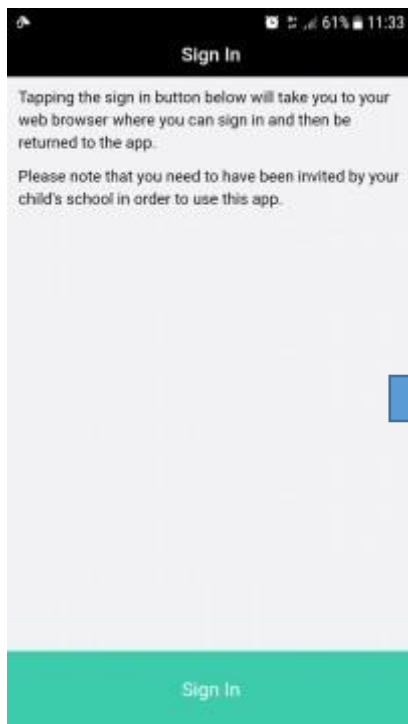
Open the App.
