Although it may seem like the pressure is huge, we are trying to reassure Year 11 that they will have as many chances as possible to achieve as high a grade as possible in each subject.

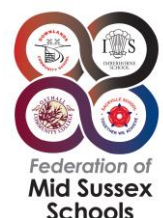
