From 6pm Students and their families from **CMO, GW, CHW and NHO** should arrive and go directly to the **Careers Fair in the Canteen and Drama Studio**.

Approx. 6.45 – GMC, FS, HH and AE to go to the Careers Fair in the Canteen and Drama Studio
CMO, GW, CHW and NHO to come to the Hall for the Information Talk and Q & A.

Please do stick to these groupings to avoid overcrowding in either the hall or at the fair. Please do stay for the talk if you are in the second group, I will endeavour to make it interesting and worth your time!

College Open Evenings are being held this term, and I attach the list of dates and times. This list is also on the school website under the Careers Page, College Open Events tab. Students are encouraged to visit colleges and providers in person to get a feel for the campus and to ask the subject tutors specific questions they may have about courses.
