We sometimes get asked in Science if there are any revision guides we recommend for GCSE. Any revision guide that is for GCSE AQA is sufficient as long as it is written after 2016 and for the correct tier and subject. As some suggestions, the following pages are some popular ones (although we are not saying these are a requirement to buy). Please note the difference between the Combined Science and Separate Science guides.

As we have mentioned before, we have a 'one stop shop' for all our resources via the 'Science KS4' SharePoint site which is accessed through the Microsoft 365 login (see image below). This includes:

- Downloadable Science Textbooks - PDF (these are the ones we use in school)
- GCSE Pod - a wide range of videos and revision resources.
- Seneca – an online self-directed textbook.
- Educake – you can undertake your own quizzes by topics and grade.
