Dear Parents and Carers,

Year 8 and Year 9 Character Enrichment Activities – 20th and 21st July 2026

At the end of the academic year, we offer two days Character Enrichment Activities (CEAs) for the whole school to contribute to their Character education. These activities have been chosen specifically to focus on building students' resilience and self-awareness, as part of our Downlands ROCKS initiative. Every student must choose an activity as the entire school are off-timetable for these days.

The next page details our CEA offer for 2026. Please review the available activities with your child and select three CEAs that they would be interested to participate in, in order of preference with 1 being their first choice. We aim to give students their first choice, but if an activity is oversubscribed, we will select names at random. Similarly, if a trip is not popular enough to run, we will offer your child their second choice - if this trip doesn't run, they will be offered their third choice. **You will receive a letter to confirm your child's CEA, giving full details of the two days activities, with payment information in a separate communication.**

Once your child has selected three CEAs that they would be interested in, click the link below to submit your child's choice; this must be done by **Friday 28th November 2025. If you enter a set of choices and then your child changes their mind just resubmit the form we will only use the latest one.**

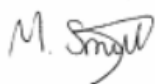
Our payment method for your child's CEA is online through SCOPAY. Full payment is required prior to the activity and by the date specified in the letter of confirmation. Advance payment is required as we must make full payment to suppliers well before July and in many cases, at the time of booking. If full payment is not received by the specified date, we will reallocate your child to a free, in school CEA.

If your child is Pupil Premium, the school will be reducing the cost of their CEA by 75% and you will be able to see the PP price on the next page. Once places have been confirmed, you will see the reduced cost on your SCOPAY.

Refunds can only be given if we are able to offer the place to another student well before the activity takes place, therefore please ensure you are fully aware of the estimated cost before completing the CEA choices form. Costs are estimated based on full capacity and anticipated costs from our suppliers. Prices may vary slightly, especially for activities using coaches, as the coach hire price remains the same whether we have 20 or 40 children, however we always try to keep the cost as near as possible to the anticipated cost.
